## 1. Presentation of KVCAP Pre-K & 0-3 Programming

Nicole Chaplin, Associate Director of Somerset County Preschool Collaboratives for KVCAP, provided an update on the district's collaboration with KVCAP. The partnership, which currently serves over 130 students, includes programming for students ages 0-5. Nicole discussed the district's pre-k programs which include classes at Canaan, Mill Stream, and North Elementary School. The program has shown positive impacts to students academics, social well-being, and health and wellness. Nicole also discussed the 0-3 year old programming (16 children) that is unique to Skowhegan. The program, which is housed in a building near Bloomfield and began 5 years ago with a collaboration with MELIG (Maine Early Learning Investment Group), offers comprehensive supports not only for the children but also for their families. The Committee expressed their appreciation and support of the partnership.
