1. Somerset Youth Collaborative Grant Updates

- David Dorr and Danielle Denis updated the committee on the work of the Somerset Youth Collaborative's work. Through this important work, students will have expanded opportunities over the summer that expand their post-secondary options after high school. Additionally, the grant is providing funding for the staff at SCTC and the High School to have training over the next two years to become a Trauma Informed Campus.

2. Data Review

- Mr. Moody reviewed data from the 2016-17 and 2017-18 State assessments in Math, ELA, and Science, the MIYHS (Maine Integrated Youth Health Survey) and local testing data.

3. 21st Century Grant

4. Rachel's Challenge
