2. Review of Proposed 2020-2021 School Budget

The Superintendent presented a review of the 2020-2021 proposed school budget.

The MSAD 54 Board of Directors is presenting a Local budget of **\$14,058,211** that shows a decrease of (-\$182,073) or (-1.28%) in overall Local Assessments for the 2020-2021 year.

Question 1: The Maine School Administrative District No. 54 school budget submitted in this Question 1 totals \$36,666,248.00. It includes locally raised funds in the amount of \$14,058,211.00, to be assessed in shares to member municipalities in accordance with the District's cost sharing formula and state law. The locally raised amount exceeds the maximum state and local spending target by \$1,085,521.30. This budget includes these cost centers and amounts:

- **Question 2: Cost Center Transfers**. Requests that the School Board be authorized to transfer amounts exceeding 5% of the total appropriation for any cost center to another cost center or among other cost centers for the 2020-2021 fiscal year, provided that transfers shall not be permitted to increase the authorized total school budget.
- Question 3: District Adult Ed Program. Requests that the District be authorized to appropriate \$356,925.00 for adult education and raise \$118,000.00 as the local share, with authorization to expend any additional, incidental, or miscellaneous receipts in the interest and for the wellbeing of the adult education program.
